Why Musbury and not Helmshore?

Musbury is the Saxon-Danish name for the four square miles of a medieval deer park centered on the Tor and Alden Musbury and Ogden Valleys, which from 1311-1507 belonged to the Crown.

Helmshore was the name given to the fields alongside the River Ogden “within Musbury” where mill owners the Turners, who were the benefactors of the Church, built their first mill. The name Musbury virtually died out as a result and is only retained by the Tor and Church and of course Musbury Fabrics!

The Church was built in 1851 and Mr Turner intended it to cost £2,000 plus bells and accommodate 600 people. Even then this was impossible and eventually cost £2,500 without the South Isle. Much of the woodwork came from Manchester Cathedral and in 1895 the marble and ceramic-mosaic flooring of the Sanctuary was laid by Italian craftsmen to the design of a Roman Villa on the Mount of Olives.

The broach spire is 150 feet high which incorporates a clock and eight “Turner” Bells. The Tenor bell has the parents name inscribed and cast on the other seven are the names of the daughters.

In 1881 the first Bazaar was held raising a staggering £867, in the following years 1899 raised £888, 1912 £1,146 and 1935 £1,000!

The Church Hall was built in 1976 at a cost of £40,000 with its official opening on the 11th June 1977.
